



NOTICE REGARDING SHOPPING TOTE BAGS

Due to incoming CPSIA (Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act) for children's products and recent media coverage, closer attention has been paid to lead standards in consumer products.

Certain news channels recently questioned the lead content found in U.S. chain-store's reusable shopping bags. These bags were fabricated and decorated in China with inks that were believed to be lead based.

At ESP's production facility, we only use certified lead-free inks to decorate our products.

All ESP tote bag material meets, or exceeds, the strictest standards for lead and phthalate content.

Although tote bags are not considered a children's product under CPSIA and regulation is, therefore, not required, ESP has initiated a standards policy to ensure quality and safety for our customers.

All current ESP stock of non-woven material tote bags have been inspected and tested for lead safety.

Strict criteria and testing standards are in place at all of ESP's offshore facilities to ensure the highest levels of product safety are met in the manufacturing process.

Verification reports for all our tote bags are available upon request.

ESP is a socially responsible participant in our community and, as such, safety standards are an integral and important value to us.
